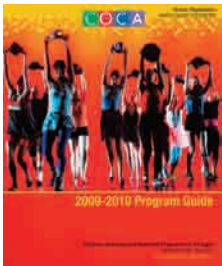


Welcome to COCA!

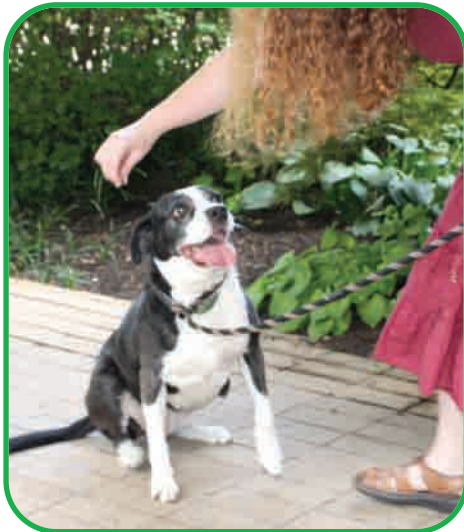
