Westminster Directions: Located near the intersection of I-64/US 40 and Highway 141, the school is on the south side of the highway. To access Westminster from the west, take I-64/US 40 eastbound to Hwy 141. Cross over Hwy 141 and continue onto the South Outer Road, staying right. Upon reaching Maryville Centre Drive, turn right into Westminster's campus. From the east, take I-64/US 40 westbound to the Maryville Centre Road exit. Turn left to cross over the bridge and drive straight into Westminster's campus.

### Online Registrations for Camps and Before & After Care

Patrons can register for a week of camp up until the Sunday before the camp starts. Example: For June 4-8 Camps, online registration will end on Sunday, June 3. Any patron trying to register for a camp once a week has started will need to go to the Registration Office.

**Before Care:** 7:30-9:00am (1 day \$15; 2 days \$30; or full week \$40)

**After Care:** 4:00-6:00pm (1 day \$20; 2 days \$40; 3 days \$60; or full week \$75)

### Camp Orientation

Camp orientation allows families to tour the facility, meet the camp manager, and ask questions about our policies and procedures.

**June Camps:** May 23, 2018 at 6:00pm

**July/August Camps:** June 20, 2018 at 6:00pm

### Ages of Campers

Camps are for students ages 3-18, and students should be the appropriate age for the camp during the week in which they are participating. Below are reasons why we believe that being the appropriate age is important:

- (1) COCA draws from many schools and areas where students tend to be advanced so our ages are true.
- (2) The age ranges are broad already.
- (3) The quality of camps remains higher if we stay true to the ages and participating campers are closer to the same age socially.

### Lunch/Snacks

**Full-Day:** Campers who are attending camp for the full day (whether for one full-day camp, or two half-day camps) should bring a lunch, drink, and two snacks. A supervised lunch will take place on campus between camps.

**Half-Day:** Half-day campers should bring only one snack/drink.

Note: Snack, juice, and soda machines are on-site, however refrigeration and microwaves are not available.

### Drop Off & Pick Up

**Drop-Off:** Below are the times when studios will open for drop-off. Campers are not admitted in the studios before these times.

- Before Care Drop-Off: 7:30-8:50am
- Morning/Full-Day Camp Drop-Off: 8:50-9:00am
- Afternoon Camp Drop-Off: 12:05-12:15pm

**Pick-Up:** All full-day and afternoon campers not registered for After Care must be picked up by 3:00pm or there will be After Care fees applied. Pick-up times are as follows:

- Morning Camp Pick-Up: 11:45am
- Afternoon/Full-Day Camp Pick-Up: 3:00pm
- After Care Pick-Up Ends: 6:00pm

### Transferring Camps

COCA offers the opportunity for students to transfer to another camp if space is available. Transfers must be submitted **before** the start of the student's camp. The Registration Office will contact the student if there is a difference in tuition.

### Withdrawing from Camp

Tuition fees will be refunded, less a \$25.00 processing fee per camp, if a withdrawal form is submitted by these dates:

**May 1, 2018** For June camps and Before/After Care

**June 1, 2018** For July and August camps and Before/After Care
