COCA is at the intersection of Trinity Avenue and Washington Avenue, one block south of Delmar Blvd.

Drop-off and Pick-up for Campers Ages 3 to 7

Those dropping off and picking up campers ages 3 to 7 should park in the garage and escort their campers directly to/from their classroom. Parents/Guardians must be listed on the Student Release Form and show ID for pick-up.

You are permitted to turn right onto Washington Avenue in order to enter the parking garage. When leaving, you may use Trinity Avenue as an exit only.

Camp Pick-up: Use Kingsland southbound to Washington Avenue westbound to access the parking garage. We have included a map for your reference.

Drop-off and Pick-up for Campers Ages 8+

Campers ages 8+ should be dropped off and picked up in the circle drive in front of COCA's main entrance (on Edward Jones Drive). Do not turn onto Washington Avenue from Kingsland. We have included a map for your reference. Follow the key for 8+. Remain straight on Kingsland and pass COCA.

Turn right at the Kingsbury Boulevard intersection (driving behind COCA)

Turn right on to Trinity Avenue (the next intersection)

Turn right onto Washington Avenue at COCA and enter our circle drive where your camper will be dropped off You will the exit via Kingsland (the way you came in)

Students with outstanding balances will NOT be allowed to re-register until the balance is paid in full.

RETURNED PAYMENT POLICY: It is COCA's policy to charge a \$25 processing fee for any returned payments (checks or credit cards). Those whose payments are returned may lose the privilege to pay via check, credit card and payment plan.

WITHDRAWALS/REFUNDS: Tuition and before/after care fees will be refunded, less a \$25 processing fee per camp, if you submit a withdrawal form by these deadlines:

MAY 1 For June camps and Before/After Care

JUN 1 For July and August camps and Before/After Care

COCA offers no refund or credit for missed camp days due to illness, schedule conflicts or any other reasons. Registration fees are nonrefundable.

VARIABLE TUITION RATES

Variable tuition rates are available for COCA Summer Arts Camps. COCA accepts applications for financial assistance beginning January 23, 2023.

Applications available online or in the Registration Office. Letters notifying applicants of their status will be emailed and registration will be available at that time.

MEDICAL WITHDRAWALS: COCA offers no refund or credit after the withdrawal deadline except for documented medical conditions. You must submit a withdrawal form and documentation on physician's letterhead. Medical withdrawals must be submitted before the last day of your child's camp. Tuition will be refunded less the \$25 processing fee per camp.

TRANSFERS: COCA offers the opportunity for students to transfer to another camp if space is available. Transfer forms are available in the front lobby and the Registration Office. Transfers must be submitted before the start of your child's camp.

CANCELLATION: In the event that enrollment does not reach the required number for a particular camp, or circumstances arise beyond COCA's control, COCA reserves the right to cancel. You will be notified, and we will be happy to work with you to find a suitable replacement. If no replacement can be settled upon, COCA will refund your money in full, less your non-refundable registration fee.

COVID-19 WAIVER: I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I/my child may be exposed to or infected by participation in COCA's in-person programming; and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, disability, and death. I voluntarily agree to assume all of the associated risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself/my child (including, but not limited to, the aforementioned exposure risks or resulting expenses of any kind), that I/my child may experience or incur in connection with my participation in COCA's in-person classes or camps, and hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless COCA, its employees and representatives, from Claims of any kind related to COVID-19. I agree that I/my child will follow COCA's COVID-19 protocols listed at this link cocastl.org/campussafety, including but not limited, to wearing a mask as required, safe social distancing, and hand washing/sanitizing during my participation.

RELEASE/WAIVER: I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless COCA and its employees from and against any and all claims for personal injuries or damages of any kind arising from participation in the COCA program. Furthermore, I authorize COCA staff and faculty to seek emergency medical help for me and/or my child if this becomes necessary. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless COCA personnel in seeking medical care for me and/or my child. I realize that every effort will be made by COCA staff to contact me in the event of a medical emergency involving my child.

IMAGE CONSENT: I agree that COCA may use my child's likeness in the routine promotion of its programs and for other non-commercial applications. To opt out, email your student's name with the subject "Image Consent Opt Out" to registration@cocastl.org.

FIELD TRIP CONSENT: I give permission for my child to leave the premises for field trips supervised by adult staff members. I understand that I will have advance information about the date, time, and location of the field trip.

COCA PRIVACY POLICY: COCA may collect the mailing addresses of its customers and will contact those patrons by U.S. mail with printed materials including special ticket offers, invitations, notices of educational programs or solicitations to support the organization.
