COCA TO HOLD YOUTH & ALUMNI AUDITIONS FOR ITS SUMMER MUSICAL PRODUCTION OF THE COLOR PURPLE

ST. LOUIS (December 21, 2023)—COCA will host auditions, January 6–7, for its mainstage summer musical production of <u>The Color Purple</u>. <u>Students and Youth</u>, Ages 10–18, and <u>COCA Alumni</u>, Ages 18+, are invited to audition. Auditions will be held in individual, five-minute auditions slots on Saturday, January 6. Callbacks and a dance call will be held on Sunday, January 7, by invitation only. Alumni also may audition by submitting a video.

Over the past two decades, COCA Summer Musicals have been a source of inspiration, talent, and community. COCA welcomes alumni to return to help us honor their significant role in the success and growth of the program. Both alumni and students will be featured on stage together for this production.

The Color Purple is a musical adaptation of Alice Walker's Pulitzer Prize-winning novel and the popular 1985 Steven Spielberg film. Featuring a Grammy Award-winning score infused with jazz, ragtime, gospel, and African blues, this moving tale is a testament to the healing power of love, faith, resilience, and sisterhood.

The Color Purple, July 20–21, will be directed by Duane Foster with music direction by Dr. Philip A. Woodmore and choreographed by Christopher Page-Sanders. COCA's annual Summer Musical, *The Color Purple*, is proudly presented by Mary Strauss.
