## COCA SUMMER MUSICALS BRING CLASSIC & CONTEMPORARY STORIES TO THE STAGE IN ONE WEEKEND

Hadestown: Teen Edition and Rodgers & Hammerstein's Cinderella to be Performed in Rotating Repertory, July 24–27

ST. LOUIS (June 26, 2025)—COCA – Center of Creative Arts concludes its 2024–2025 COCApresents Season performance series with two dynamic musicals—Hadestown: Teen Edition and Rodgers & Hammerstein's Cinderella (Enchanted Edition)—that will be presented in rotating repertory over the course of one weekend, July 24–27. COCA's Summer Rep showcases the versatility and talents of COCA's musical theatre pre-professional artists as they perform contrasting musicals.

"We are so excited for COCA's Summer Rep productions of *Cinderella* and *Hadestown: Teen Edition!* Our students have the unique and exciting challenge of rehearsing and performing both musicals in one summer," said Will Bonfiglio, COCA's Artistic Director of Theatre. <u>Hadestown: Teen Edition</u> by Anaïs Mitchell is an intriguing and beautiful folk opera that delivers a deeply resonant and defiantly hopeful theatrical experience. Following two intertwining love stories—that of young dreamers Orpheus and Eurydice, and that of immortal King Hades and Lady Persephone—*Hadestown: Teen Edition* invites audiences on a journey to the underworld and back. Inspired by traditions of classic American folk music and vintage New Orleans jazz, Mitchell's beguiling sung-through musical pits industry against nature, doubt against faith, and fear against love.

Hadestown: Teen Edition is directed by Grace Austin, with music direction by Khalid McGhee and choreography by Christopher Page-Sanders. Performances are Friday, July 25 at 7:00 p.m., Saturday, July 26 at 7:00 p.m., and Sunday, July 27 at 6:00 p.m. Hadestown: Teen Edition includes mature language, sexual themes, depictions of violence, and substance use. The musical is recommended for ages 10 and up.

The Tony-nominated Broadway adaptation of <u>Rodgers & Hammerstein's Cinderella</u> is a beloved musical that will put a spell on audiences of all ages and make them believe in the impossible. *Rodgers & Hammerstein's Cinderella* showcases some of the songwriting duo's loveliest tunes, including "In My Own Little Corner," "Impossible/It's Possible," and "Ten Minutes Ago."

Rodgers and Hammerstein's Cinderella is directed by Shawna Flanigan, with music direction by Dr. Philip A. Woodmore and choreography by Alisa Cooper. Performances are Thursday, July 24 at 7:00 p.m., Friday, July 25 at 10:00 a.m., Saturday, July 26 at 1:00 p.m., and Sunday, July 27 at 1:00 p.m.
